
MRS. ANNIS'S 5TH GRADE CLASS OCTOBER 26, 2015

Students build new lists every Friday. I will check all lists for correct spelling. Students have a choice of one of the following practice methods which we will do for about 10 minutes each day. They can choose to:

- Write their words ten times each.
- Rainbow words: consonants in one color, vowels in another.
- Read, cover, spell, check: an effective memorization strategy.
- ◆ Stair step words: write the word in
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- Spelling Scribble: an artistic way to practice spelling.

"Don't practice until you get it right... practice until you can't get it wrong."

Spelling partners will quiz each other on their individual lists on Wednesday. Students will be able to focus on the words they still need practice with in time for their spelling test. On Thursday, spelling partners test each other while I monitor and check their progress. Students have the weekend to at home to study as well and I encourage you help your child review their words!
